Clinical Research Facility



The Clinical Research Facility at the University of Tasmania's Medical Science Precinct is a state-of-the-art, purpose-built facility for undertaking participant-based and translational health and medical research.

We support collaborations between health and medical researchers and conduct a variety of research projects and clinical trials.

The facilities include eight GCP compliant examination and interview

rooms, five procedure rooms and a mini-theatre, a phlebotomy room with conjoined sample preparation laboratory, gymnasium, tea room, bone density scanner, walking track, and a restricted access, temperature controlled drug storage area for investigational products. Participants are met within the reception area, and study researchers are notified of their arrival.

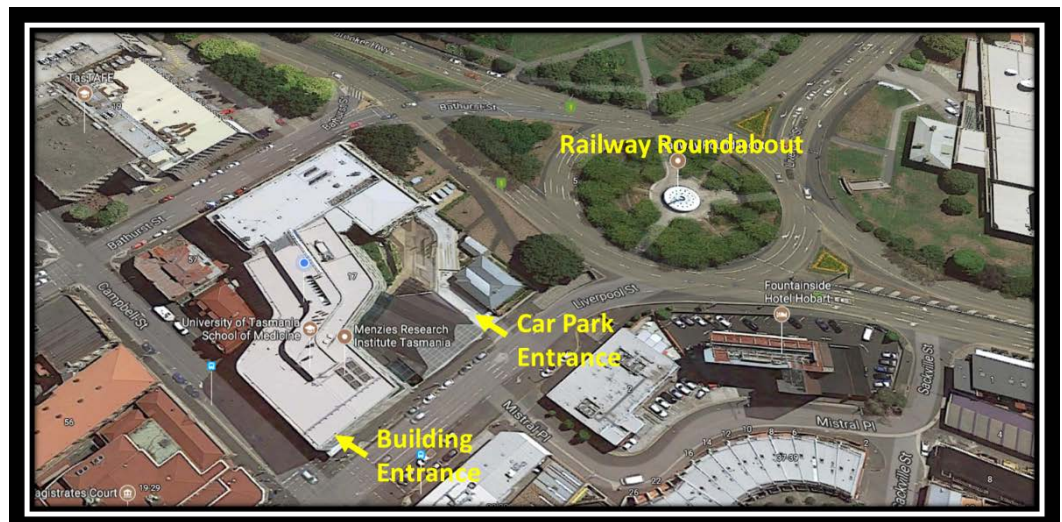

Location:

The Clinical Research Facility is located on level 3 of the Medical Science Precinct of the University of Tasmania. The Medical Science Precinct is located in central Hobart, Tasmania, in close proximity to the Royal Hobart Hospital.

Participants need to report to ground floor reception on arrival before proceeding to the level 3 Clinical Research Facility. Entry into the parking area is off Liverpool Street (with entry from the Railway Roundabout).
